Section 3: Supplemental (Non-Vacancy Specific) Recruitment Activities Undertaken by Seehafer Broadcasting

1. 07/14/2025, N.D a Senior from Two Rivers High school, started working through the **CESA 6 Youth Apprenticeship program** as a sports intern at the stations. N.D. will be pursuing a sports broadcasting degree after high school.
2. 09/17/25 10-12p, all Seehafer Stations were represented at the Wisconsin Broadcasters Job/ Career Fair in Middleton.
3. 9/27/25- 10/30/25, all Seehafer Stations ran an aggressive commercial blitz to encourage student enrolled in Broadcasting to apply for grant money. The Wisconsin Broadcasters Association Foundation offers three \$2,500 scholarships and one \$1,500 scholarship to assist students enrolled in media related educational programs at public or private colleges/universities, broadcast/media schools and Wisconsin Technical Colleges.
